A HANDBOOK ON THE RULES

FOR POSTING OF WORKERS

The main objective of the project *Informing on the Rules of Posting, IOR*, funded by the European Union is to provide **quality information** to both posted workers and posting employers, to improve the implementation and correct application of European rules on the posting of workers, and to increase the accessibility, transparency and quality of information on the terms and conditions of employment, especially in agriculture, care and construction.

To meet this core objective of our project **IOR**, among other activities, we have prepared a ***Handbook on the rules of posting of workers in a transnational provision of services, for posted workers and posting employers***. The document aims to be a basic compilation of information related to the posting of workers in a generic way, while incorporating challenges, recommendations and good practices specifically related to the three sectors targeted in the Project: agriculture, care and construction.

This *Handbook* is therefore designed to help workers, employers, social partners and authorities involved in these processes to better understand the rules of posting of workers and its proper procedures.

The *Handbook* sets out the necessary differences in terms of specific information to be considered for workers and employers and has been translated into the languages of all the partners participating in the Project: Spain, Bulgaria, Poland, Germany, the Netherlands and the Czech Republic, as well as into English. Its purpose was to extend it to the rest of the EU Member States and the candidate countries.

The *Handbook* contains a brief description of European legislation on posting, focusing on the problematic situations that may exist in the posting of third-country nationals, the rights and duties of posted workers and their employers, and a reference to outstanding challenges and recommendations or good practices that need to be implemented.
